The soft, breathable belt can be fastened at the front or at the back. Being able to apply the product from the back provides more dignity for residents.

With more elasticity and width increased by 40%, the ComfiStretch™ belt now fits larger waist sizes while providing great leakage security.

The distinctive blue FingerLift™ tab combines with the white belt to clearly show where the belt opens. This helps get the product ready for application more quickly.

Wide and adjustable hooks can be fastened and re-fastened as many times as necessary without losing grip properties. Easy to grip, even when wearing gloves.


